

<p>Chronicle News</p> <p><u>Egremont Signaller's Death</u></p> <p>News has been received by Mrs. E. Addison, of 41 Ricehey Road, Egremont, of the loss of her third son, Pte. Ralfon Addison, of the Royal Warwickshire Regiment, who made the supreme sacrifice on the 26th October. Pte. Addison, who was 27 years of age, enlisted in the Army Ordnance Corps in November, 1916, and after being transferred to the Royal Warwickshire Regiment, went to France in the early part of this year, being attached to the signal section of his battalion. For eleven years he was in the employ of Messrs Bahr, Behrend & Co., of Chapel Street, Liverpool, and attended St. John's Church and also St. Columba's.</p>
