News Report

Liscard Plumber Killed

The parents of Private George E. Anthony, 53, Liscard Village, have received official intimation of his death in action in Egypt, on the 27th December last. Private Anthony, who was only in his 20th year, voluntarily joined the Army in November, 1914. He afterwards took part in the disastrous expedition to the Dardanelles from whence he was invalided home, and subsequently sent to Egypt where he met his untimely end. He was a bright, soldierly looking young man of exemplary behaviour and great promises, as well a general favourite with his schoolfellows and chums by whom he will be greatly missed. He was educated at St. Mary's Schools, Liscard, and previously to joining up was apprenticed with Mr. A.A. Tipping, plumber, Wallasey Village. Much sympathy is felt for Mr. and Mrs. Anthony in their sad bereavement. They have another son serving his country in the Navy. Private Anthony attended St. Thomas' Church, Seaview Road, Liscard.
