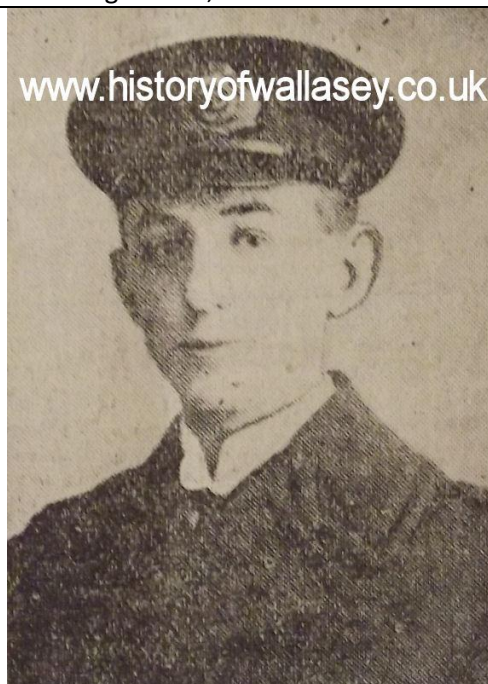

Lost At Sea

Stanley Rossiter Bath was lost at sea on September 15th, through the torpedoing of s.s ----- . He was 22 years of age, born in Wallasey, and was educated at Seacombe Wesleyan School. He was an active worker in connection with the Egremont Presbyterian Band of Hope, and was also a prominent member of the 3rd Wallasey Boy Scouts. He was a son of Mrs. Bath, and of the late Mr. J.T. Bath, 82, Clarendon Road, Egremont.
