<p>News Report</p> <p><u><a href="#">Brothers At Uveco Mills</a></u></p> <p>The sad intelligence has been received of the death from wounds on April 3, at the Military Hospital, Rouen, of Pte. John Bennett, Cheshire Regt. Twenty-seven years of age, he was educated at Wallasey old school, and previous to joining up in August, 1915, he was employed with the Uveco Cereals Ltd., Birkenhead Road, Seacombe. He had been in France eighteen months. He attended St. Luke's Church, and was the third son of Mrs. Mary Bennett, and of the late Mr. Samuel Bennett, 7 Cedar Grove, Poulton. He leaves a widow and one child to mourn his loss.</p> <p>Private <a href="#">Edward Bennett</a>, Cheshire Regt., aged 25 years, has been reported as missing since July 31, 1917. He enlisted in August, 1915, and had been six months in France. He was educated at Poulton Council School, and was in the</p>
