New Zealander Killed

The sad intimation has been received that Pte. Fred Betteley, New Zealand Regt., was killed in action on April 5. He joined up in June, 1915, and had been eighteen months in France. Twenty-nine years of age, he was educated at Riverside Council School, and had for several years been in business in New Zealand. He was the eldest son of Mr and Mrs George, 31, Ilchester Road, Seacombe. His wife is at the same address.
