Norman Birkhead, of the King's Liverpool Regt., and formerly of the Lancashire Hussars Yeomanry, died from wounds on July 5, at the Field Ambulance, France. He was educated at the Old Bardsley School, Rake Lane, Liscard, and was formerly employed with Mr. C. Corry, butcher, Victoria Road, Seacombe, and a member of the Rake Lane P.S.A., Brotherhood. He was the only son of Mr. and Mrs. G.H. Birkhead, 2, Mossy Bank Road, Egremont, and leaves a widow and two children to mourn his loss.</p>
