News Report

Wallasey Captain Killed In Action

We regret to announce the death of Captain Charles William Boote, Cheshire Regiment, who was killed in action.

The deceased, who was 27 years of age, was the younger son of Mr and Mrs A.S. Boote, of 'Wolleston', Grove Road, Wallasey. He was educated at Mr. Wrigley's High School, Seabank Road, afterwards proceeding to King's William College, and graduated at Emmanuel College, Cambridge, obtaining a degree of B.A and LL.B. He then served his articles with Messrs. Bartley, Bird and Co., solicitors, Liverpool. Having been a member of the Cambridge Officers' Training Corps, and obtained his commission upon the outbreak of war, he served almost throughout the whole of the Gallipoli campaign, and took part in both evacuations. He received his captaincy last September. Much regret will be felt in Wallasey with the relatives of the young officer, whose promising career has been terminated by the great sacrifice.
