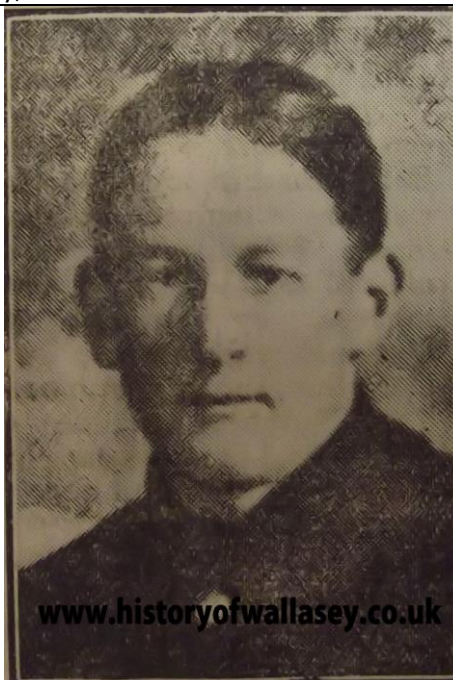

News Report

Killed In Action

Official news has been received that Private Peter Bramwell, of the Cheshire Regiment, was killed in action in France, on September 30th. He enlisted at the outbreak of the war, and had been overseas for three and a half years, when he was wounded. He was in his 24th year. Was educated at St. Mary's School, Liscard, and was formerly by Messrs. Cooper and Co., Church Street, Liverpool. He was the youngest son of Mr and Mrs Bramwell, 11, Valkyrie Road, Liscard.
