News Report	<p><u>Died In Action</u></p> <p>News was received on Wednesday morning, by Mrs. Brock, of 19, Russell Road, Wallasey, of the sudden death from shock of her son, Lance Corporal John Brock, of the Cheshire Regiment; He joined the Cheshires in September, 1914, and went to France twelve months later. He was formerly in the employ of Messrs. Clarke, Muir and Co., cotton brokers, Liverpool. Company Q.M.S. Tellet, writing to the mother of the deceased, said that the lad, who was only nineteen years of age, was a great help to him, and had just received his first stripe. Had he been spared, he was a likely lad for further promotion.</p>
