#### Reported Killed

Private Joseph (Joe) Bullock, Cheshire Regt., who was reported in the 'Wallasey News,' on October 27, as wounded and missing somewhere in France on September 20, has been officially posted as killed or died from wounds on the above date. Twenty-two years of age, he was the youngest son of Mrs. S. J. Bullock, of Egremont, and of the late Mr. E.J. Bullock, Wavertree.
