<p>Chronicle News</p> <p><u>Liscard Sergeant Killed</u></p> <p>Mr and Mrs J. Bushell, of 6, Wellesley Road, Liscard, have received information to the effect that their son, Sergt. Arthur Bushell, has been killed in action. The late Sergt. Bushell was well known in sporting circles, where his death will cause keen regret, for he was popular both in Wallasey and Wavertree as a footballer and cricketer. Prior to the war he was employed by Messrs. Houlder Bros, the well known shipping firm, and joined the King's Liverpool Regiment immediately on the outbreak of hostilities. A letter received by his parents from the adjutant speaks very highly of him as a soldier, and also states that he carried out the duties of scout, and had charge of bombing parties and snipers.</p>
