Canadian Highlander Killed

We regret to learn the Pte. Reg Carlisle, of the Canadian Highlanders, has been killed while on active service. He was the only son of Mr. and Mrs. Carlisle, 9, Tollemache Street, New Brighton. As recently as February 16 Mr. Carlisle received a letter from his son in which he stated that he was looking forward to early leave, but in the attack on February 18 the gallant young soldier was numbered amongst the killed. No details of the sad occurrence have yet been received by his parents. Pte. Carlisle, who was a smart looking lad, 23 years of age, was educated at Egerton Street Schools, New Brighton, and finished his education at the Manor Road Schools, Liscard. Before going to Canada he was steward on the Allan liner Virginia.
