The death is announced of a well-known entertainer – Private Dean Carmody, of Tollemache Street, New Brighton, who was professionally known as Billie Deane. The young fellow was in the 4th Cheshires, and had only been at the front a few days when he was killed.

Another Local Loss

A wide circle of friends will deeply regret to learn that Private Carmody 1/4th Cheshires, of 24, Tollemache Street, New Brighton, was killed on the field in action at the Gallipoli Peninsula, on August 19th. He was not yet nineteen years of age, and enlisted on the outbreak of war with the local "Terriers." He was

well-known in the district as an amateur comedian under the name of Billy Deane. He organised a benefit concert for the Empress of Ireland Relief Fund, and had also taken part with the Black and White Entertainers, and in the Wallasey Cyclists' and Harriers' Carnival. He worked with his father, Mr. J.J. Carmody, for the River Plate Meat Company, 8, Wallasey Road.
