<p>News Report</p> <p><u>Dies From Pneumonia</u></p> <p>The sad intelligence has been received that Pte. Edward Henry Carroll, Cheshire Regt., died from pneumonia on July 23 at the V.A.D. Hospital, West Hartlepool. He joined up in August 1914, and had been for over three years in France and Salonika, and was twice previously wounded. He was educated at Rock School, Magazine Lane, and formerly employed by the Wallasey Corporation at the Detractor Works, Poulton. Much sympathy has been expressed for the widowed mother in the sad loss of her eldest son. Her husband, the late Mr. Edward Carroll, was twenty years driver for the old Wallasey Omnibus Company. The funeral with full military honours, takes place on Monday at Rake Lane Cemetery, prior to which there will be a service at Emmanuel Church at 11 o'clock.</p>
