#### News Report

##### Dies From Inflammation

Mrs Hannah Carroll, of 13, Greenbank Avenue, New Brighton, has received the sad news of the death of her second son, Pte. George Carroll, Royal Welsh Fusiliers, at the General Hospital, Alexandria, from inflammation in the middle of the ear. He was only 20 years of age, and joined the Army on March 12<sup>th</sup>, 1917, and was drafted to Egypt last Christmas. He was educated at Rock School, Magazine Lane, and attended the Congregational Mission, Field Road.

His brother [Pte. Edward H. Carroll](#), died from pneumonia on July 23<sup>rd</sup>, at the V.A.D. Hospital, West Hartlepool.
