<p>News Report</p> <p><u>Missing</u> (December 1918)</p> <p>Pte. John Robert Carson, of the 13th Cheshire (1077) is reported missing since July 7, 1916. He joined the Army in August, 1914, and was drafted to France in September, 1915. Thirty-two years of age, he was educated at St. Mary's School, Liscard, and was by trade a painter and paperhanger. Any information from comrades or returning prisoners of war will be thankfully received by the only sister, Mrs. J., Deakin, 384, Poulton Road, Wallasey, Cheshire, late of 3, Adelaide Street, Poulton.</p>
