Son Of The "Boot Inn" Host

The death is officially announced of Private Alexander Robert Cash, of the Cheshires, which occurred from dysentery at the General Hospital, Amars, Mesopotamia. He was 23 years of age, and joined the Army on January 31st, 1916. Before enlisting he was employed as an engineer by the Birkenhead Motor Company. He was the only son of Mr. and Mrs. W.H. Cash, of the Boot Inn, and 27, Greasby Road, Liscard (late of the Dolphin Hotel, Birkenhead), to whom great sympathy will be extended.

The deceased was educated at Annan, on the borders of Scotland, and afterwards at the Poulton Roads Schools.
