Private William George Chadwick (13th Cheshire Regiment), of 17, Mount Pleasant Road, Upper Brighton, is unofficially reported missing. A letter from his brother, dated 12th July, conveyed the news to his home. He was fighting in a distant theatre of the war.

Private Chadwick, who enlisted when war started, was formerly an enthusiastic member of the Rake Lane P.S.A. Bowling Club, and in this connection he was awarded a set of woods as the winner of one of the *Chronicle* merit competitions.
