<p>News Report</p> <p><u>Always Did His Duty</u></p> <p>Private T. Cheadle, the husband of Mrs. Elizabeth Cheadle, of 48, Sherlock Lane, Poulton, was killed on August 15<sup>th</sup>, through the bursting of a shell. He was educated at St. Alban's Schools, Liscard, and was a motor driver. The O.C. writes to Mrs. Cheadle saying that the deceased was standing near the entrance of a dug-out, when a shell fell almost on top of it, killing him instantly. "Your husband," he added, "always did his duty right well, and is missed by both officers and men."</p>
