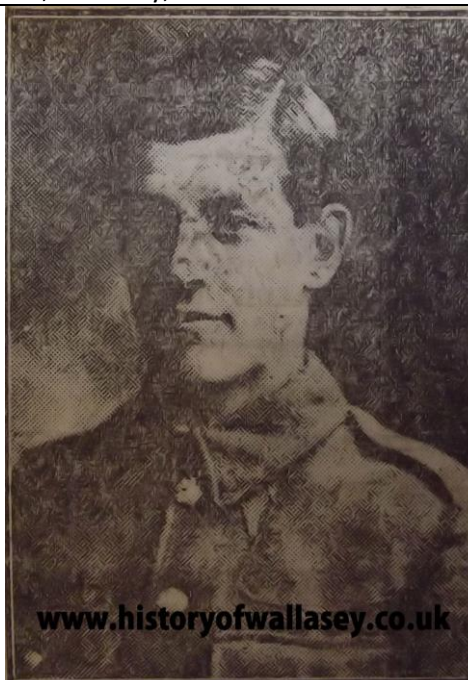

Missing Now Reported Killed

Pte. W.L. Clare, Royal Inniskilling Fusiliers, who has been missing since May 19, 1917, is now officially posted killed in action on that date. He joined up in August, 1914, and had been in France since May, 1915. He was 24 years of age and formerly in the service of Mr. W.L. Milne, shipping purveyor, Birkenhead. He resided with his sister at 13, Evelyn Road, Somerville.
