John Water Clements, Army Service Corps, died of burns (but no particulars are to hand) on September 11th, at the Australian General Hospital, Port Said. He joined up on January 17, 1917, and was drafted to Egypt in February of the same year. He was formerly for thirteen years in the service of the Liverpool tramways. He leaves a wife and five young children, who reside at 83, Urmson Road, Liscard.</p> | |
