Riverside Boy Killed

The sad intelligence has been received that Pte. George James Clough, Cheshire Regt., was killed in action on March 24. He joined up on September 7, 1914, and has been two and a half years in France. He was previously wounded in the knee and hand. He was educated at Riverside Council School, and followed a sea-faring life. He was the eldest son of Mr. and Mrs. G.J. Clough, 61, Wright Street, Egremont. His brother Robert was killed in action over two years ago, and four other sons are in the army in France, Salonica, Malta and Egypt respectively.
