<p>News Report</p> <p><u>Killed at his Post</u></p> <p>Pte. D. Clowes, K.L.R., whose home was at 22, Windsor Street, New Brighton, has been killed in action in France. His officer, writing to relatives says: "It is with very great regret and deep sympathy that I write to you to inform you of the death of Pte. Clowes, who was killed instantly at his post of duty on March 28. He died like a true British soldier, for the freedom of his country, and I trust that in your grief some small measure of comfort may be gained in this knowledge." Pte. Clowes, who was wounded in the foot and leg in March 1917, leaves a widow and four daughters.</p>
