| <p>News Report</p> <p>Came From Canada To Join</p> <p>The sad intelligence has been received of the death of Private John Henry (Harry) Condell, who was killed in action on September 25<sup>th</sup>. He was employed with Nelson's. Limited, Cold Storage Co., and went to Canada five years ago. He came home to join the Colours in August, 1915, and went to France last August. He was educated at Egerton Street and Manor Road Schools. As a boy he was a keen footballer and played in the North v. South match. He was the eldest son of Mrs Martha Condell, 6, Prescot Street, Liverpool, who has another son (aged 22), a lieutenant in the Navy.</p> |   |
