Well-Known Swimmer Dies of Wounds

The news of the death of Lieut. T.G. Cooper, of the Machine Gun Corps, as a result of wounds, will occasion widespread regret amongst his friends in Liverpool and Wallasey. Prior to the war Lieut. Cooper was on the staff of Sir Percy Bates and Co., ship-owners, and joined up with the Liverpool Pals on their formation. He was a well-known swimmer, being late hon.secretary of Everton S.c., and held the position od chairman of Everton Ladies S.C. Lieut. Cooper, who was educated at the Liverpool College, formerly resided with his parents at 20, Warwick Drive.
