Liscard Lieutenant Killed

Intimation has been received of the death of 2nd Lieut. George H. Copland, of the King's Liverpool Regt., who was killed in action on July 31. He joined the Army soon after the outbreak of the war, and was wounded at the end of June last year, and had only recently got his commission. He was educated at the Liverpool Institute, and was formerly in charge of the Marine Insurance Company department of Messrs. Stott and Co., ship brokers, Liverpool. He was the only son of Mrs. Copland, and of the late Mr. George R. Copland, 'The Sycamores,' Holland Road, Liscard.
