#### News Report

The sad news has been received of the death from pneumonia on October 18<sup>th</sup> at the General Hospital, Salonika, of Driver Frederick Coventry, Royal Garrison Artillery. He joined the Army in May, 1916, and was drafted to Salonika two years ago. Twenty-four years of age, he was born in Wallasey Village, and educated at St. George's Council School.

He was formerly a market gardener, and before enlistment was employed at the Wallasey Corporation Destructor Works, Poulton. He was the youngest son of Mr Thomas Coventry, of 12, Leasowe Avenue, and his wife and little daughter reside at 4, Byerley Street, Seacombe.
