<p>New Report</p> <p><u>Captain Craigmile Killed</u></p> <p>We regret to state that Capt. Alexander Murray Craigmile, M.C., the eldest son of Dr. and Mrs. Craigmile, of Manor Road, Wallasey, is reported as having been killed in action on March 29. The gallant captain, who was In the Rifle Brigade, was 23 years of age. He had the Military Cross conferred on him for gallantry, the following being the official record:—"For conspicuous gallantry and devotion to duty. When his company was ordered forward to reinforce, he got into position with great ability and consolidated the position. Later he most skilfully advanced his whole line, and displayed fine leadership under most difficult conditions. He set a splendid example to his men throughout the whole operation."</p>
