<p>News Report</p> <p><u>Wallasey Lance-Corporal Killed</u></p> <p>Lance-Corporal John Stanley Crellin, of, the King's Liverpool Regt., who was reported "missing" in our issue [Wallasey News] of September 2, 1916, is now officially reported killed in action on July 30, 1916. The brave soldier, who was 29 years of age, was the youngest son of Mrs. S.A. Crellin, and of the late Mr. George Crellin, "Greeba," Queensway, Wallasey. He was formerly employed with the Mersey Docks and Harbour Board, a member of the old New Brighton Boating Club, and attended New Brighton Wesleyan Church.</p>
