##### Poulton Soldier Killed By Bursting Shell

Pte. Arthur Birkett Croman, of the Royal Welsh Fusiliers, who was reported in the "Wallasey News" as wounded on July 22, 1916, was killed in action by a bursting shell on July 19, 1917. He was educated at St. John's (Birkenhead) School, and was a printer by trade. He was the sixth son of Mr. and Mrs. J. Croman, Sherlock Lane, Wallasey, and his wife resides at Beresford Road, Dingle, Liverpool.
