New Brighton To New Brighton Seaman

We regret to record the death of Seaman James Cross, R.N., of pneumonia, which occurred on November 1st, at Ramsgate Naval Hospital, at the age of 28 years. He joined the Navy on May 14th, 1917, and was the third son of Lifeboat Coxswain and Mrs. Cross, 9, Tollemache Street, New Brighton. He leaves a widow and baby.

The funeral took place on Thursday, of last week, with Naval honours, at Rake Lane Cemetery, and was preceded by a service at St. James' Church, New Brighton, conducted by the Vicar, the Rev. Canon Stonex, Rural Dean, who also performed the last rites at the graveside, in the presence of a large assemblage. There were many floral tributes.
