News Report

Naval Officer's Death

We regret to record the death of Sub-Lieutenant Eric Lemurrie Cubbin, which occurred on September 27th. The deceased, who was in his 21st year, was educated at Wallasey Grammar School, and had served three years in the Navy. He was the youngest son of Mr and Mrs William Cubbin, Cliftonville, Breck Road, Wallasey.

The funeral took place on Thursday at Rake Lane Cemetery. The coffin, draped with the Union Jack, was carried on a gun carriage drawn by a naval gun crew of H.M.S. -----, under the command of Capt. Metcalf.

An impressive service was conducted at the Cemetery Chapel by the Rev. Aaron Smith, pastor of the Primitive Methodist Church, Seacombe, who also officiated at the graveside. The body was borne by naval men in its last resting place. Three volleys were fired, and a bugler sounded the "Last Post."

The funeral arrangements were directed by Mr S. Gibbons, Liscard.
