<p>News Report</p> <p><u>Seacombe Engineer Drowned</u></p> <p>The death is reported of Engineer George Cubbin, who is lost at sea on December 28th. The deceased, who is the son of Captain Cubbin, formerly in the service of the Wallasey Ferries, resided at 53, Walsingham Road, Seacombe, and for the last three or four years served with the pilot service, prior to which he was engaged by the Maclyer Line. He was the son-in-law of Mr. S. Gregory, late inspector of Wallasey Post Office, and leaves a widow and one child.</p>
