Reported Killed

Pte. Alfred Daniels, Cheshire Regt., who was reported as missing on July 24, is now officially posted as killed in action. He joined the Army in the early part of 1916, and was drafted to Egypt, and afterwards sent to France, where he had only been a couple of weeks before meeting his untimely death. He was 25 years of age, and was educated at Somerville Council School, and formerly was employed as carter with the Wallasey Corporation. He was the third son of Mrs. Sarah E. Stebbins, and of the late Mr. Joseph Daniels, Smithy Lane, Seacombe.
