<p>News Report</p> <p><u>Fatal Wounds</u></p> <p>Private Frederick Maylor Davies, Machine Gun Corps, who was previously reported in the "News" as wounded on July 31st by bursting shell, in the right cheek and left thigh, whilst rescuing a comrade from danger, who had fainted. The sad intelligence has now been received that he died of wounds in the chest and back on October 7, at the Casualty Station, France. He was formerly employed with Mr. W.P. Ferney, jeweller, 39, Victoria Street, Seacombe. Much sympathy will be felt for his wife and three young children, who reside at 44, Hallville Road, Seacombe.</p>
