<p>News Report</p> <p><u>New Brighton Corporal Killed</u></p> <p>The sad intelligence has been received that Corpl. Harry Davies was killed in action on November 4. He was the first volunteer in the road where he resided to join the Cheshire Regt., on August 14, 1914, and in February, this year was drafted to Palestine. He was educated at Rock School, Magazine Lane, and attended the Field Road Mission, his favourite pastime being football. He was the third son of Mr. and Mrs. J. Davies, of 19, Sandridge Road, New Brighton.</p>
