##### U Boat Victim

Another local victim of the U-boat outrages is Robbie Davies, son of Mr and Mrs W.T. Davies, of 25, Tudor Avenue, Seacombe, who has lost his life through the torpedoing of the steamer on which he was serving. The deceased, who was about 17 years of age, was educated at Riverside Council School, and joined the Naval Cadet Corps (attached to the R.N.V.R.) rising to the rank of petty officer. After serving a year in the office of Mr G.H. Stanton, a Liverpool cotton broker, he entered the employ of the Gulf Line Steamship Company, and was on his third voyage when he lost his life.
