<p>Chronicle News</p> <p><u>Lost With H.M.S. Goliath</u></p> <p>Amongst the brave men who have lost their lives when H.M.S. Goliath was torpedoed and sank in the Dardanelles, on May 13<sup>th</sup>, was Private John Harrison Dean, Royal Marine Light Infantry, husband of Mrs. Jenny Dean, 4, Grange Avenue, Liscard, and eldest son of Mrs. Dean, 5, Chamberlain Street, Poulton.</p> <p>The deceased, who was 37 years of age, was very well-known in the borough from the circumstances that he had been employed for some years on the Wallasey Corporation's electric tramways. He was very popular with his fellow employees, and their deep sympathy will be extended to his bereaved widow and child. He was a reservist, and had served on the ill-fated Goliath since the fleet was mobilised in August last.</p>
