News Report

Former Scout Killed

The sad official news has been received of the death in action on Sept. 27th of Pte. John William Ernest (Jack) Dickinson, King's Liverpool Regt. He was only in his 18th year, and enlisted in May, 1915, and had been in France since last July. He was educated at Somerville Council School under Mr. Griffin, and was formerly in the office of Messrs. Chalmers, Wade, and Co., chartered accountants, Liverpool. He was for seven years a member of the 7th Wallasey Boy Scouts, and during Alderman T.V. Burrow's Mayoralty acted as one of the scouts body guard. He was also a member of Mr. White's Bible Class. He was the eldest son of Mr. Herbert G. And Nurse Dickinson, 24, Lea Road, Egremont, and grandson of the late Mr John Dickinson, a former member of the Board of Guardians for South Seacombe Ward. Much sympathy has been extended to the family in their sad bereavement.
