Seacombe Quartermaster Killed

Private {J} Harold Dobson, of the Cheshire Regiment, was killed in action on Saturday, April 21st, and, although no official notice has yet been received from the War Office, a letter has been sent to his parents from the chaplain, and there is therefore little doubt that the news is but too true. Private Dobson had been out in France about nine months, and was originally in the R.G.A. before being transferred to the Cheshires. He was only 25 years of age, had been married four years, and leaves a widow and one child, who are at present residing at 16, Ellis Street, Seacombe, with his parents. The Dobson family is well known in Seacombe,, and two brothers are at present serving with the forces, one being in France and the other having been in the Navy four years. The father is at sea, and is due home on Sunday, when the sad news will have to be broken to him. Harold was the eldest of the sons, and before the war

followed the sea, being a quartermaster on the China boats and other lines.
