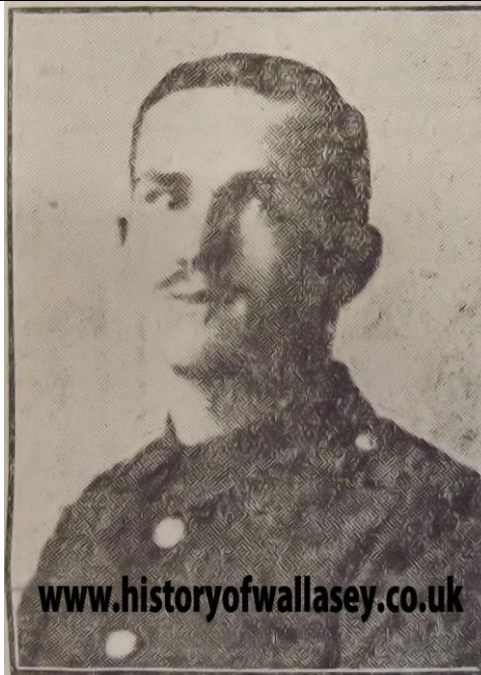

News Report

Died a Prisoner of War

Intimation has been received of the death of Gunner H. Dodd, Royal Garrison Artillery, who joined up at the commencement of the war, and had been in France two years. He was gassed in February, 1917, wounded and taken a prisoner on November 30, and died on December 16. Twenty-three years of age, he was formerly engineer in the service of the Virginia Laundry and a keen footballer. He resided at 1, Seymour Street, New Brighton.
