News Report	<p><u>Local Violinist Killed</u></p> <p>Notification has been received that Sapper and Miner Frederick Arthur Dovey, Royal Engineers, was killed in action, between October 22-27. He joined up in November, 1914, and was drafted to France in 1915. He was educated at Rake Lane Congregational School, and was formerly a clerk in the Secretary's Registry G.P.O., London. Well-known as an accomplished violinist, he was second son of Mrs M.L. Dovey, and of the late Mr Henry Dovey, of 42, Church Street, Egremont, and Victoria Street, Liverpool. He was also a cousin of Mr W.H. Jude, the musician evangelist. His wife resides at Westcliffe-on-Sea, London.</p> <p>Sapper Dovey was decorated on the field for distinguished bravery, only a few days before he fell, and had it not been for the untimely death, would have been presented with the Medal by the King, on his next leave.</p>
