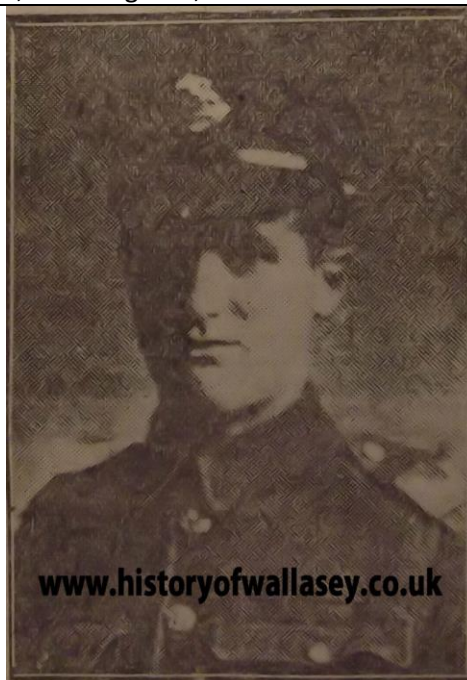

News Report

Pneumonia Victim

Private Frank Duckworth, Cheshire Regiment, was wounded in the left leg and arm in June, 1917, and again last March, in the left hand by gunshot. He came home on leave, but on returning to Squire Gate Military Hospital, Blackpool, he caught a chill, and died from bronchial pneumonia, on November 1st. He was a son of Mrs. Elizabeth Duckworth, and of the late Mr. Henry H. Duckworth, 33, Hope Street, New Brighton. Much sympathy has been expressed for his mother and family in their sad bereavement.

The funeral took place at Rake Lane Cemetery, the last rites being performed by the Rev. Canon Stonex, Rural Dean, Vicar of New Brighton.

A large number of floral tributes were sent from his sorrowing mother and family, relatives and friends, the Commanding Officer, V.A.D. Sister and Staff of Hospital, Blackpool.

The funeral arrangements were carried out by Mr. J. Kenna, Brighton Street, Seacombe.
