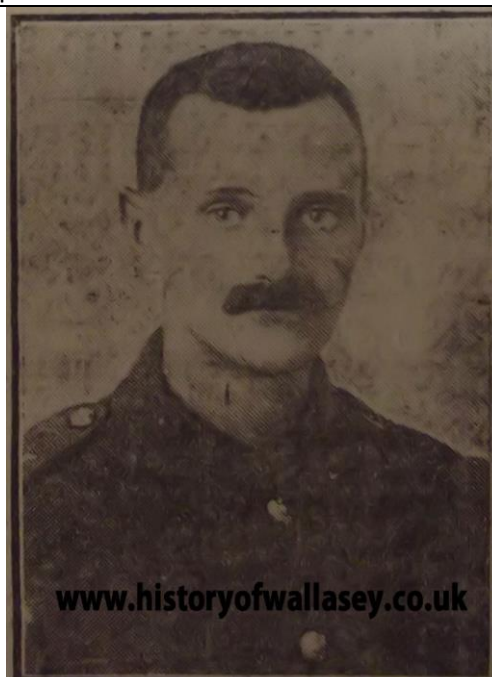

News Report

The Late Private W. Duckworth

We deeply regret to record the death of Pte. William Duckworth, which occurred on Tuesday of last week at West Didsbury Military Hospital as the result of illness contracted whilst on active service in France. He was the eldest son of the late Mr. Joseph Duckworth, "Saltaire," Cambridge Road, Southport. Pte. Duckworth joined the King's Liverpool Regt., voluntarily in November, 1915, and had seen one and half-year's hard fighting in France, where he had been wounded. He was 31 years of age, and was educated at University School, Southport. He was admitted a solicitor in 1910, commencing practice three years later. The deceased was very highly esteemed as a sidesman and Sunday School teacher at St' Luke's Church, Poulton, and also as a member of the Church of England Men's Society (Poulton branch). Much sympathy has been expressed for the widow and three young children in their irreparable loss.
