<p>News Report</p> <p><u>New Brighton Soldier Dies From Wounds</u></p> <p>The sad intelligence has been received that Pte. Harold Eddington, of the Cheshire Regt., died from wounds received in the shoulder on June 12. Thirty-two years of age, he was educated at St. James School, New Brighton, and was by trade a journeyman painter. He joined the colours March, 1916, and had been in France eight months. He was the youngest son of Mrs. J.A. Eddington, and of the late Mr. Chas. Eddington, Cafe, Marine Promenade, New Brighton. Two other sons are in the Army.</p>
