Died At Clearing Station

The sad news has been received that Lance-Corpl. Frank Edwards, Ling's Liverpool Regt., was wounded on October 29, and died at the Casualty Clearing Station on November 2 after a severe operation. He joined the Army in April, 1916, and had served nine months in France. He was educated at Birkenhead Institute, where he gained the senior Oxford certificate, and was employed in the rates department of the Liverpool Corporation. He was the only son of Mr and Mrs A.H. Edwards, 37, Walsingham Road, Wallasey.
