Killed While Leading A Charge

"He died at the head of a party of his company charging the enemy. It was an act of unnecessary bravery, as he might have detailed it to a subaltern."

In those few words the story is told of courage which Caption Charles Fleetwood Ellerton displayed on the fateful night of May 17th, when he was killed while leading an attack on the crater which the Germans were holding.
