<p>News Report</p> <p><u>Died Of Enteric</u></p> <p>Mr and Mrs E. Ellison, of 15, Limekiln Lane, Poulton, have received the sad news of the death of their youngest son from enteric fever, which occurred on October 2 at the British Hospital, Corfu. He was 27 years of age, and was rejected for military service at the outbreak of the war. Subsequently he was accepted for the R.A.M.C. in October 1916, and was drafted to Corfu in July, 1917. He was educated at Rake Lane Congregational School under Mr Bardsley, and attended Manor Road Wesleyan Sunday School, and formerly was employed by Councillor C.F. Rhymer as salesman and collector for the Quality Coal Co.</p>
