News Report

New Brighton Corporal Killed

We regret to announce that Corporal Charles Henry Ferguson, of the King's Liverpool Regt., who was previously reported "missing" on August 13, 1916, is now officially presumed by the War Office to have been killed in action. The brave soldier, who was 28 years of age, was educated at the Merchant Taylors' School, Great Crosby, and was outside town surveyor for the Royal Insurance Company, Liverpool. He was for several years a member of Emmanuel Church, Fazakerly, and was very fond of boating. He joined the army at the outbreak of the war, and had been in France since February, 1915. He was the only son of Mr and Mrs C.F. Ferguson, 74, Sudworth Road, New Brighton. Amongst a large number of sympathetic letters received by the parents is one form Mr. George Chappell, manager of the insurance Company.
