Fletcher (Bert) is lying seriously wounded in the War Hospital, Bradford, suffering from wounds in left hip, left arm, and head and shell shock. The latest news from the hospital says that he is slightly better.

#### Died From Wounds

It was reported in the "Wallasey News" on Saturday that Pte. A.R. Fletcher (Bert), of the Cheshire Regt., was lying seriously ill at the War Hospital, Bradford, suffering from wounds in left hip, left arm, and head, and shell shock. News has now been received that he died after long suffering on November 6<sup>th</sup>. He was interned, on November 8<sup>th</sup>, with full military honours at Scholemoor

Cemetery, Bradford. He was the son of Mr and Mrs E. Fletcher, 31 Ashville Road, Seacombe.
